Monday, September 20, 2021  
Regular Meeting Minutes

- Jay called the Meeting to Order at 7:00 pm.
- Introductions were made.
- There were no changes to the Agenda.
- The Minutes were reviewed and signed.
- The Mail was reviewed.
- Warrants were reviewed, approved, and signed.
- The Road Commissioner gave his report.; bank stabilization project completed by Mosher; and the new hydrant on Hale Hollow was completed.
- Josh Linton appeared and spoke about his constable position. He would like to keep his certification, and there would be no cost to the Town for the class. It would be for a level 2 officer, who could do a misdemeanor, can make an arrest, can do traffic stops, domestic violence response. Can be a help when Sheriff is not on duty. Josh will work on an agreement between the Town and him.
- Kirk Turner spoke about the new fire truck. They spent \$1,500 for a grant writer; they will wait until March to request money to see if they can get a grant. If they do get a grant, they may return and request money for extrication equipment.
- Regarding the letter from concerned residents about F&W and the South End Road sign, Rick and Keith felt it could be removed with permission to put it out from mid-June to mid-August, as it is a safety concern.
- Under new business: the delinquent tax report was discussed; it was felt that a two-year wait was too long and that the SB will set policy per the manual. A special meeting was planned; ARPA funds were discussed.
- Under old business: the Kam Johnston hearing was discussed; as was the website and building maintenance, and the audit.

The Meeting was adjourned.
