

SELECT BOARD MEETING

OCTOBER 3, 2022 @ 6:00 PM

Town of Plymouth Municipal Building

The meeting was called to order at 6:02 PM by board chairperson Jay Kullman.

In attendance were selectmen Keith Cappellini, Rick Kaminski, and Jay Kullman.

Also in attendance were Beth Graves-Lombard, Terry Bascom, Craig Obriskie, Bruce Pauley, Stephanie and David. (I apologize I did not clearly hear their last names).

ARPA Funds were first on the agenda, with the review for the Tyson Library. The Select Board reviewed their written request. They had volunteers who continually worked to service the library, and the work met the criteria and goals of the community center. Jay asked for the motion; Rick made the motion to accept the Tyson Library request for ARPA funds, was second by Keith.

Jay passed out two policy handbooks, one currently in use dated 2018, with a second proposed from Cynthia with NEMRC. NEMRC is New England Municipal Resource Center, which helps to support towns with their daily operations. It was asked that board members review both packets and Jay will work on a draft that incorporates the best of both policies. The goal is to make additions to the policy that will be more uniform and efficient. No time line set for approval.

Rick announced a cell tower meeting scheduled for Tuesday, October 4th at 2:30. The meeting is to discuss a location of where to place the tower.

Rick also shared the roof has been started on the annex building. The old shingles were removed, and rotted plywood was exposed. It will be replaced and the new roof and repair will be completed as scheduled.

A new boiler has been installed in the current municipal building. Rick shared the advantages of how this new boiler can be incorporated into the new improvements of the municipal building. It would assist during power outages, and give the town an opportunity to use propane or electric if prices start rise.

The discussion went towards the Bond approval for financing the renovations of the current municipal building. Rick has talked with an attorney. A warned conference call is scheduled for Wednesday October 5th at 5:00. The attorney is Robert Frederick out of Burlington who specializes in assisting municipalities with financing.

The meeting adjourned 6:32 with the select board heading into executive session.
