

**OFFICIAL WARNING
AUSTRALIAN BALLOT VOTING**

**TOWN OF PLYMOUTH SPECIAL TOWNMEETING
November 8, 2022**

The legal voters of the Town of Plymouth are hereby notified and warned to meet in the Plymouth Municipal Building in said Town on November 8, 2022. The polls shall open at seven o'clock in the morning (7:00 a.m.), and shall close at seven o'clock in the evening (7:00 p.m.), during which time the following articles are to be acted upon by Australian ballot:

TOWN ARTICLES

Article 1A: Shall the Town of Plymouth borrow up to an additional EIGHT HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$800,000.00) through a Municipal Bond to pay for the full and propose weatherization/deferred maintenance project to be paid back over a 20-year period?

Article 1B: Shall the Town of Plymouth proceed with the weatherization/deferred maintenance project and only complete portions of the project with the funds previously authorized by the Voters in the amount of \$950,000.00?

Article 2: Shall the Town of Plymouth adopt the Declaration of Inclusion as signed by Governor Phil Scott in 2021 to condemn racism and welcome all persons to live freely and express their opinions as stated in the proposed language for a Plymouth Declaration of Inclusion as written below:

The Town of Plymouth condemns racism welcomes all persons, regardless of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, gender identity or expression, age, or disability, and wants everyone to feel safe and welcome in the community.




Article 3: Shall the Town of Plymouth declare itself a Second Amendment Sanctuary town?

The legal voters of the Town of Plymouth are further notified that voter qualification, registration, and absentee voting relative to said meeting shall be as provided in Chapters 43, 51 and 55 of Title 17, Vermont Statutes Annotated.
