1. Call to Order:
 - a. Jay Kullman called the meeting to order at 8:00 AM.
2. Select Board to Review and Approve – Private Cemetery Request:
 - a. Richard Olmstead spoke about the private cemetery request located at 854 Kingdom Road. Their family had spoken to Andy Crossman, and Andy told them that they needed to get approval from the Select Board. Rich said they used GPS coordinates and staked out a 40 x 40 foot section where Randy Shimps remains will be. Rich said that Randy Shimp had been cremated. This is just to protect the area in the event that they were ever to sell the land. He also indicated that a right-of-way would also be required prior to them selling.
 - b. Rick Kaminski made a motion to approve the request. Jay Kullman seconded the motion. The motion carried.**
3. Select Board to Review and Approve BIDS for F600:
 - a. Rick Kaminski began by stating that two (2) BIDs were received for the RFP for the Town Highway Ford F600 that was being sought after. One was Formula Ford and the second was Claremont Ford.
 - b. Rick said Formula Ford did a Cab & Chassis as well as the back which was above what the RFP outlined; however, it was approximately \$8,000+/- cheaper than Claremont Ford. This BID did not include the midship, therefore, Rick asked Cherry to call and confirm Michael said that it wasn't, but they would include it with no additional charge. Which it was. The delivery for the Cab & Chassis from Formula Ford was 14-16 weeks although it could be quicker, but that is always unknown. The exact Cab & Chassis is currently on the lot at Claremont Ford which means no waiting time.
 - c. Rick Kaminski made a motion to go with the BID from Claremont Ford for the following reasons: They currently have the Cab & Chassis on the lot, which means immediate delivery then the back can be placed on it so hopefully within a few weeks we will have the truck. The second reason is that the Ford F550 that the Highway currently has might have a rear-end or transmission issue that could go at any time. If we wait for or delay for too long, we might end up putting thousands of more dollars into the F550 waiting for the new truck. Also, the**

extended delay or other unknowns with Formula Ford might take us into snowy weather again depending on timing. Jay Kullman seconded the motion. The motion carried.
